- I. What is the <u>history</u> between law and grace?
 - A. Jesus <u>confronted</u> those who evaluated people based on how many "laws" they kept or broke.
 - B. Paul taught the <u>law</u> in itself did not offer <u>life</u>.
 - C. Luther: We are saved by <u>grace</u> alone through <u>faith</u> alone in <u>Christ</u> alone.

- II. What really is the dilemma?
 - A. Many fear if we preach this it will feel as if we just gave a <u>permission</u> slip to people to sin.
 - B. Others teach <u>none</u> of that matters to God.
 - You were <u>dead</u>
 - · But _ Gold
 - C. In Christ we fight <u>FROM</u> a place of victory and reject the lie that we are fighting <u>FOR</u> victory.

- III. What is the myth buster? Ephesians 2:10
 - A. We are created in Christ Jesus for <u>good</u> works.
 - "Your conversion is your <u>commission</u> and your baptism is your <u>ordination</u>." Hirsch
 - B. You have been crafted to be in the game.

If you have received salvation, it was by **grace** alone through **faith** alone in **Christ** alone.

But God... made you alive and put you right into the action.

The work you were created to do is done for the sake of Christ, and it brings glory to God.
