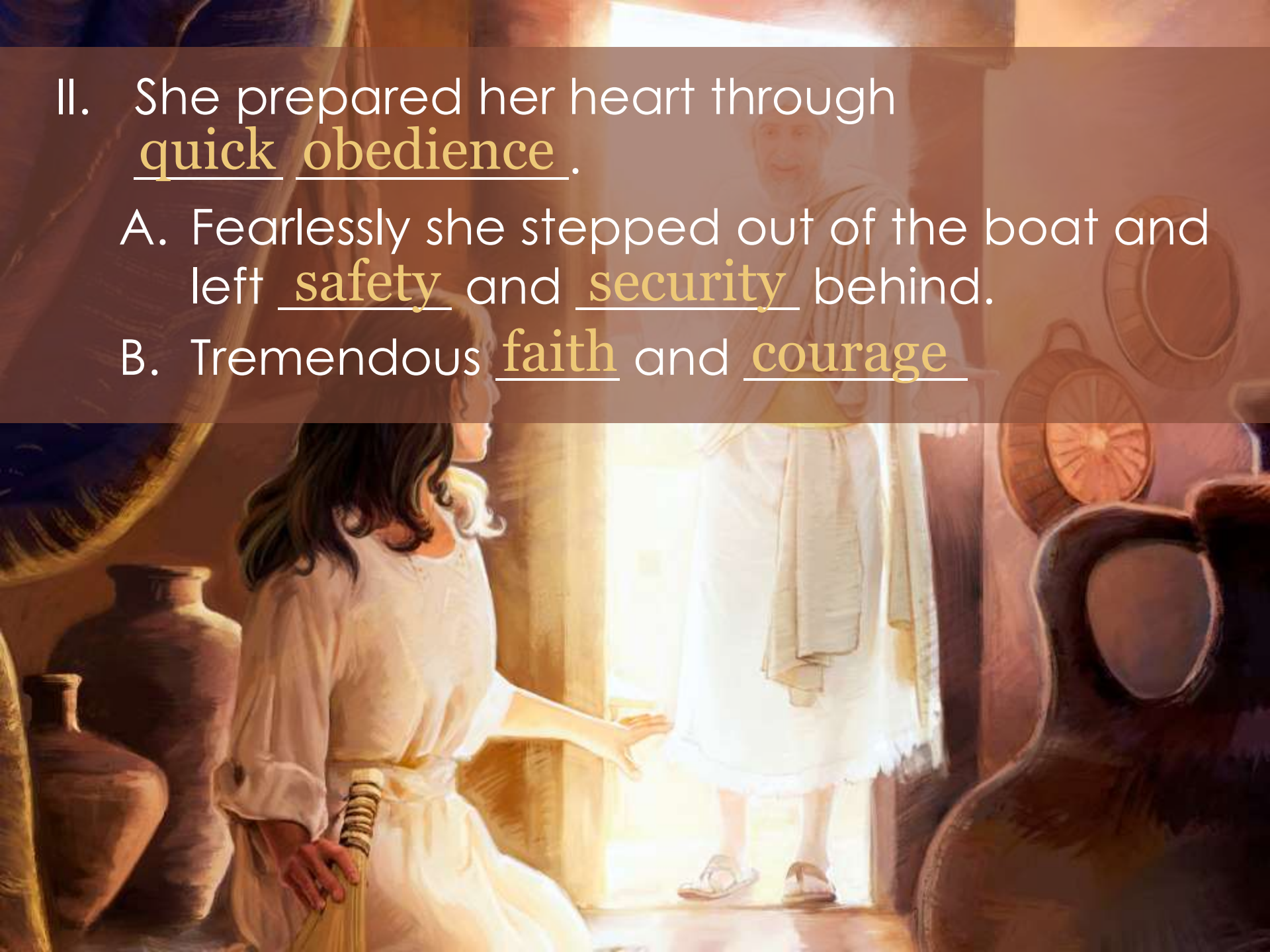

III. She prepared her heart by pressing in to where God was at work.

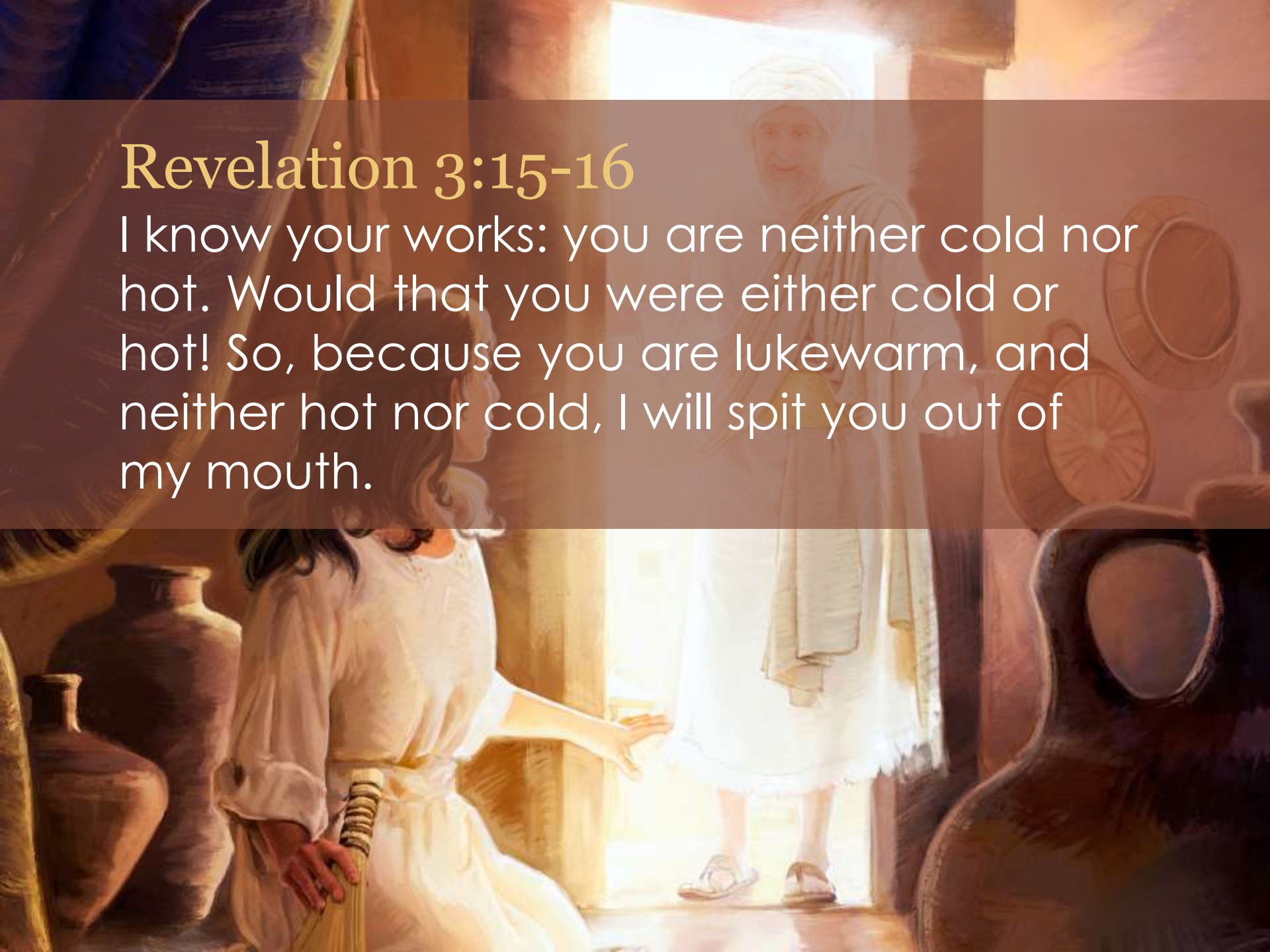
