- I. We need to know what is <u>historically</u> accurate.
 - A. Some believe Luke's account is <u>unreliable</u>.
 - B. There was <u>faith</u> in Jesus before some of this physical evidence had been unearthed.

- II. Remember your <u>God</u> encounters.
 - A. The shepherds encountered <u>Jesus</u> and <u>angels</u>.
 - B. Such encounters are followed by:
 - Pressing <u>into</u> what just blew your mind.
 - The enemy causing you to question.
 - C. The beauty of personal experience: it is mine.
 - D. Life experiences increase <u>courage</u> to share.

- III. Ask God to <u>highlight</u> who you need to engage.
 - A. "All who <u>heard</u> it wondered..."
 - They were not <u>ashamed</u> to tell the story.
 - Not everyone <u>heard</u> it.
 - It wasn't their job to convince.
 - B. Our encounters are personal <u>faith</u> builders.
 - C. God uses us to <u>share</u> and <u>introduce</u> the next person to the Good News of Jesus.
