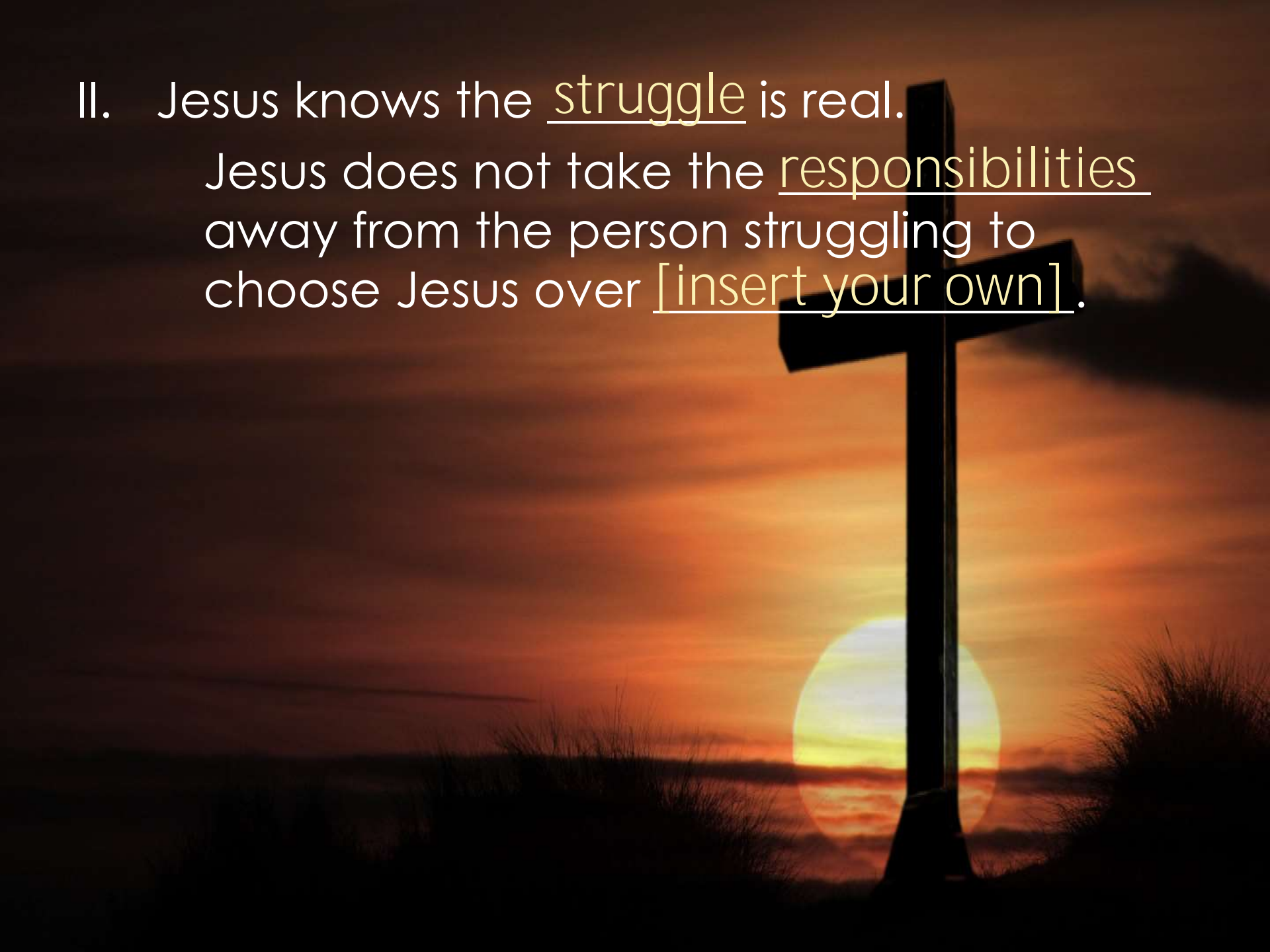


I. Jesus loves this man.
