B. God: He is <u>FOR</u> you; he intends for you to <u>thrive</u>!




1 Peter 5:8 (ESV)


Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.

- II. 4 <u>elements</u> of what it means to have God at work as our <u>redeemer</u>
 - A. God is our <u>deliverer</u>
 - In scripture deliver refers to setting <u>captives</u>
 free
 - B. God is our <u>Savior</u>
 - Jesus saves us from our sin and the consequences our sin would bring
 - C. God is our <u>rescuer</u>
 - God is still in the business of plucking us out of the <u>darkness</u> & placing us in the <u>light</u>

- II. 4 <u>elements</u> of what it means to have God at work as our <u>redeemer</u>
 - D. God is our <u>Redeemer</u>
 - When God redeems he takes something that was rotting and he makes it <u>new</u>
 - A redeemer is needed when a situation is bleak
 - Some situations are so bleak the only way out is a <u>ransom</u> fee
 - God's timing is <u>perfect</u>
 - God has promised to be working through every circumstance of Christians to produce good

1 John 2:1-2 (ESV)

My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

Colossians 1:13-14 (NIV)

For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Mark 10:45 (ESV)

For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.
