Chapters: introduced in the 1200's.

Verses in the 1500's.

- 1. (12) We ask you brothers to respect those who labor among you.
 - a. And are over you in the Lord.
 - b. And admonish you.
 - c. (13) And to esteem them very highly in love because of their work.
 - d. Be at peace among yourselves.
- 2. (14) And we urge you brothers.
 - a. Admonish the idle.
 - b. Encourage the fainthearted.
 - c. Help the weak.
 - d. Be patient with them all.

- 3. (15) See that no one repays anyone evil for evil.
 - a.But always seek to do good.
 - b.To one another.
 - c.And to everyone.
- 4. (16) Rejoice always.
 - a.(17) Pray without ceasing.
 - b.(18) Give thanks in all circumstances.
 - c.For this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

- 1. (19) Do not:a.Quench the Spirit.b. (20) Do not despise prophecies.
- 2. (21) But test everything.a.Hold fast what is good.b. (22) Abstain from every form of evil.
- (23) Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely.
 - And may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
 - (24) He who calls you is faithful.
 - He will surely do it.

- (25) Brothers, pray for us.
- (26) Greet all the brothers with a holy kiss.
- (27) I put you under oath before the Lord to have this letter read to all the brothers.
- (28) The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

Note: this was written directly to the <u>body</u> of believers.

- 1. Paul asks that the body of believers to know, respect, appreciate those who <u>labor</u> among them.
 - A. Know, Respect, Appreciate.
 - B. Based on observing them.
 - C. When they carry out their <u>assignment</u>.



- 2. Paul urges/exhorts the body of believers <u>TO DO!</u>
 - a. Urge your fellow <u>brothers</u> and <u>sisters</u> on.
 - b. Lay aside the need to <u>get</u> <u>even</u> forgive.
 - c. Be a follower of Jesus that is <u>filled</u> with joy.



Psalm 64:10:

Let the righteous one **rejoice** in the Lord and take refuge in him! Let all the upright in heart exult!

Psalm 97:11-12:

Light is sown for the righteous, and joy for the upright in heart. **Rejoice** in the Lord, O you righteous, and give thanks to his holy name! Psalm 104:33-34:

I will sing to the Lord as long as I live; I will sing praise to my God while I have being. May my meditation be pleasing to him, for I *rejoice* in the Lord.

Isaiah 61:10:

I will greatly **rejoice** in the Lord; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

Habakkuk 3:17-18:

Though the fig tree should not blossom, nor fruit be on the vines, the produce of the olive fail and the fields yield no food, the flock be cut off from the fold and there be no herd in the stalls, **yet I will rejoice** in the Lord; **I will take joy** in the God of my salvation.

Philippians 4:2-5:

I entreat Euodia and I entreat Syntyche to agree in the Lord. Yes, I ask you also, true companion, help these women, who have labored side by side with me in the gospel together with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life. **Rejoice** in the Lord always; again I will say, rejoice. Let your reasonableness be known to everyone. The Lord is at hand.

- 3. Paul tells them what <u>not to do</u>.
 - a. The "Do Nots" are a short list.
 - i. Do not <u>quench</u> the Spirit.
 - ii. Do not <u>despise</u> prophecies.
 - Logos: the Totality of God. John 1:1-5
 - Rhema: <u>Specific</u> to a situation. Eph. 6:17
 - b. Test everything.
