I. We are fully devoted to Him.

Sanctified – set apart for Holy use.

A. This generation had never been circumcised.

C. We will need to follow God-ordained steps that point to the obedience of our hearts to God.



II. We are living by our faith (not trusting in the faith of our fathers and mothers).

A. Are we demeaning the faith of our parents?

B. What is a testimony for one generation can become a religious snare for future generations.

C. God says, "Will you give Me ALL of you?"



III. We do the hard work of obedience and healing.

A. The obedience was painful – but necessary.

B. Healing can't be rushed but it can be delayed and derailed.

C. God's goal was to roll away their reproach.

Is your faith in Jesus YOUR faith?

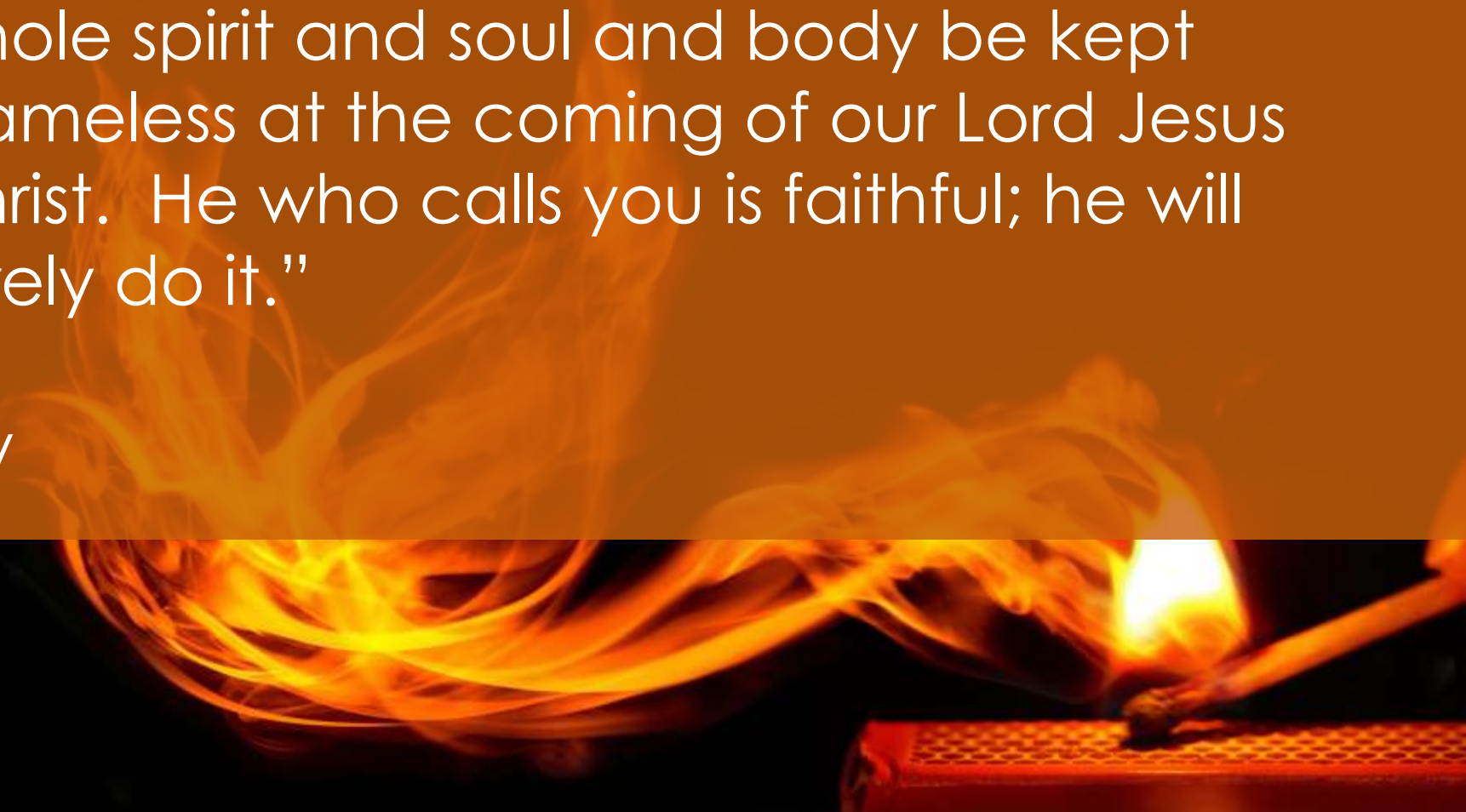
Are you doing the hard work of healing ?
