

- I. From elevation to <u>desperation</u>. Joshua 7:1-6
 - A. <u>But</u>...
 - B. Joshua and the nation do not seem to know.
 - C. They just keep <u>moving</u> on.





- A. Joshua falls apart.
- B. He <u>blames</u> God.



- III. From devastation to <u>education</u>.

 Joshua 7:10-15
 - A. God: "Just <u>STOP</u> it already!!!
 - B. <u>Israel</u> sinned, transgressed, broke covenant.
 - C. We have to consider <u>our</u> role, <u>Satan's</u> role and the consequences of living in a <u>fallen</u> world.



- IV. From condemnation to <u>separation</u>.

 Joshua 7:16-26
 - A. This was a day of <u>reckoning</u>.
 - B. And again WE ask, "How could God ..."



The road of righteousness has two ditches.

The ditch on the right is the ditch of Legalism.

The ditch on the left side is the ditch of cheap grace.

Neither ditch worships Holy God.

Am I on the road of <u>righteousness</u> or am I in the ditch?
