A. Joshua falls apart.

B. He blames God.



III. From devastation to education.

Joshua 7:10-15

A. God: “Just STOP it already!!!

B. Israel sinned, transgressed, broke covenant.

C. We have to consider our role, Satan's role and the consequences of living in a fallen world.

IV. From condemnation to separation.

Joshua 7:16-26

A. This was a day of reckoning.

B. And again WE ask, “How could God...”
