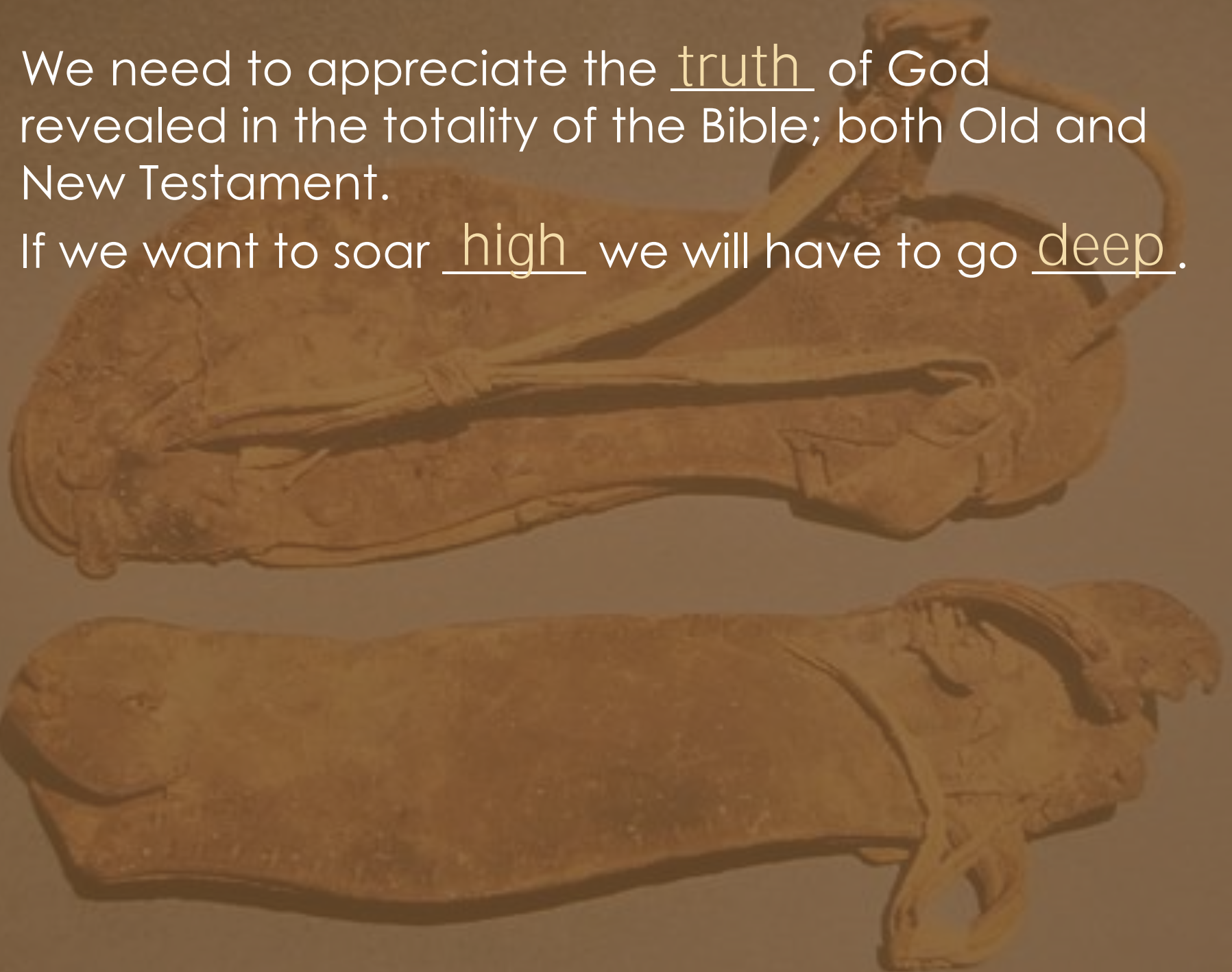

We need to appreciate the truth of God revealed in the totality of the Bible; both Old and New Testament.

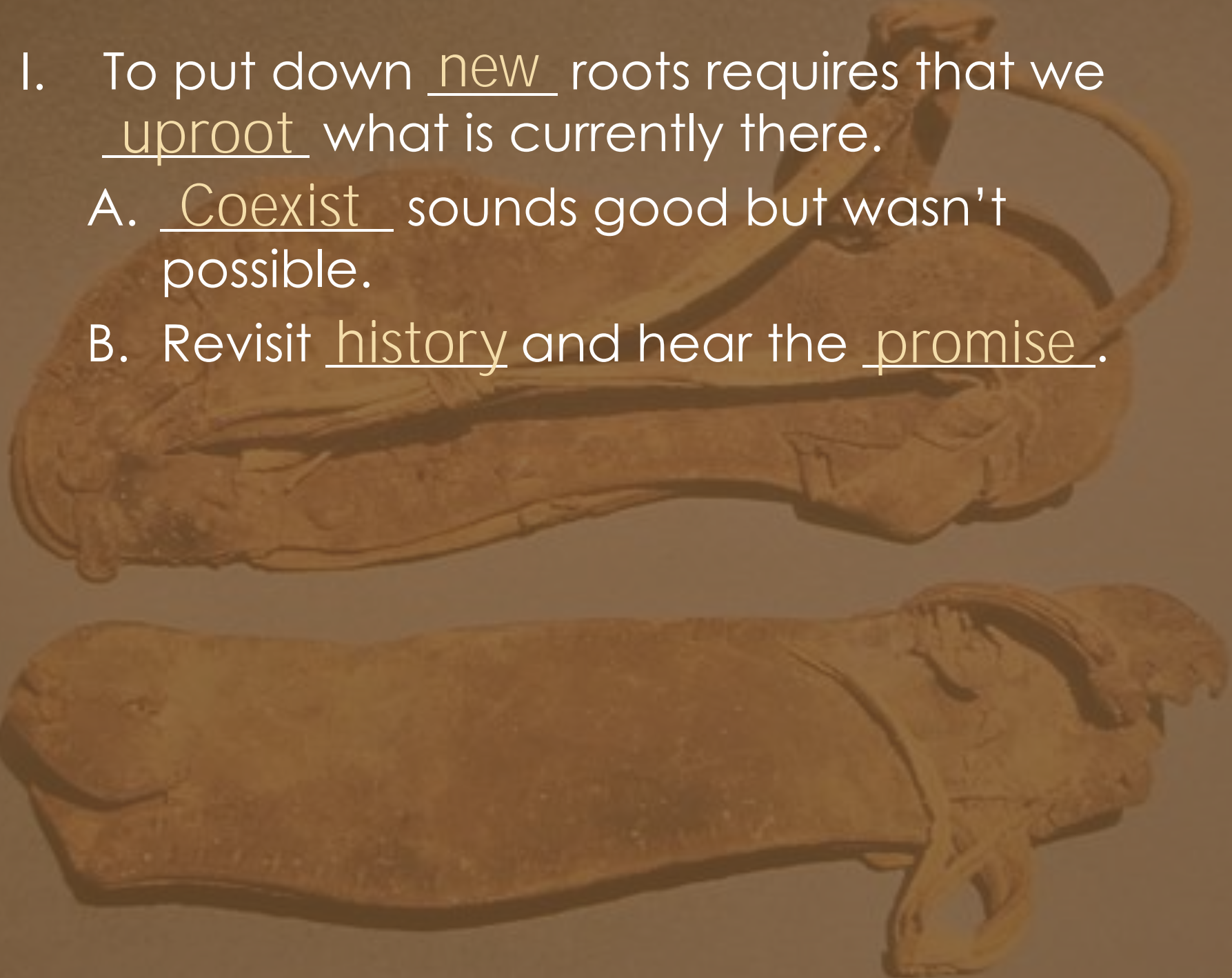
If we want to soar high we will have to go deep.
