  - B. Mary's call was not to short-term <u>mission</u>.

  To <u>protect</u> the Hope of the world.
  - A. Dream #1 stay <u>vigitant</u>. Matthew 1:18-25
  - B. Dream #2: stay mobile. Matthew 2:13-15
  - C. Dream #3: stay flexible. Matthew 2:19-21
  - D. Dream #4: stay <u>adaptive</u>. Matthew 2:22-23
