

- I. When Jesus steps on your toes...
 - often it is deliberate.
 - A. Jesus will step on your toes when you have a critical spirit.
 - B. Jesus will step on your toes when you have an unteachable spirit.
 - C. Jesus will step on your toes when you have a selfish spirit.
 - D. Jesus will step on your toes when you have an embarrassing sin problem or something to hide.

II. When Jesus steps on your toes...
don't resist Him but respond with
obedient faith.

A. We resist Jesus when we respond in anger
and resolve to get rid of Him.

- How do you respond when God's Word
confronts your sin?

II. When Jesus steps on your toes...
don't resist Him but respond with
obedient faith.

B. We respond with obedient faith when we
believe and act on Jesus' Word.

- He recognized and admitted his need and inability.
- He believed in Christ's ability to heal him.
- He acted in obedience to Christ's command.



When Jesus steps on your toes or
knocks on the door of your heart,
don't resist Him. Respond with
obedient faith, and He will save you
and use you for His glory!
