- D. Luke 19:9-10 I came to seek and save.



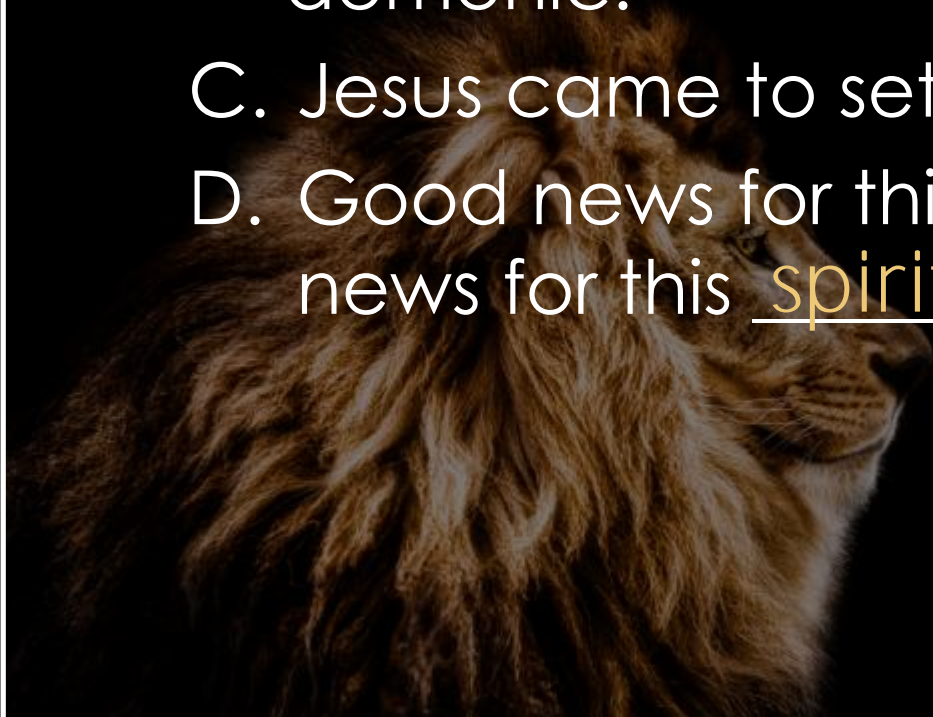
III. The Glory of God came up against an assignment from hell.
