







- I. Breathe in rejoicing in the Lord: celebration.
 - A. Finally rejoice! IN the Lord!
 - B. The message is not a <u>problem</u> for me and it is <u>safe</u> for you.
 - C. Why would Paul <u>repeat</u> himself?
 - 1. To be heard.
 - 2. To reinforce the truth.
 - 3. Until your feelings fit the facts.



- III. Breathe in <u>right-placed</u> celebration.

 Philippians 1:8-14.
 - A. Rejoice in the Lord because you gained Christ.
 - B. Intentionally keep Jesus as the object of worship or the <u>rubbish</u> piles up.
 - C. This **joy** is because Jesus made me His own.



- There are other voices telling us where we can find our joy.
- But the object of our <u>worship</u>, the reason we <u>rejoice</u>, is Jesus.
- As citizens, lean into the <u>constitution</u> of heaven and trust His promise to complete in us what He has begun.
