If you want to see the most abnormal and uncomfortable Advent ever, just look at the <u>first_one</u>.

In spite of how good we have it compared to the first Advent, we struggle with having our gaze locked downward.

Advent characters with eyes stuck downward suddenly able to look up

- » Zechariah
- » <u>Mary</u>
- » <u>Joseph</u>
- » Wise Men
- » <u>Shepherds</u>

- I. <u>Lift up</u> your eyes
 - A. Away from doom and gloom
 - B. Lift your eyes to something <u>higher</u>.
 - C. Turn your eyes onto <u>Jesus</u> who remains steady and victorious.
- II. Look all around.
- A. Find the <u>bigger</u> <u>picture</u>.
- B. God is <u>beautifully</u> at work in the world and in you as he was in Mary.

- III. Look all around and <u>See</u>.
 - A. When you look all around you will see God.
 - B. And God is still up to his good work.
 - C. The real problem with looking down is we lose sight of <u>GOd</u>.

- IV. When you look up and see God you will be RADIANT.
 - What we look at <u>grows</u>.
- V. When you look up your heart will thrill and exalt.
 - A. Heart here means your <u>inner</u> disposition.
 - B. When we look up God says our heart will grow and expand.
