## The theological term is <u>Christo-centric</u>.

- I. I Corinthians 2:1-5 THIS IS ALL ABOUT <u>Jesus</u>.
  - A. Paul is referring to his first trip to Corinth.
  - B. What Paul did not do was try to <u>impress</u> them.
  - C. But in demonstration of the <u>Spirit</u> and of <u>power</u>
  - D. Christ and Him crucified is the MILK.

- II. I Corinthians 1:10-17 Christian cannibalism
  - A. They divided themselves based on what church <u>leaders</u> they liked more.
  - B. There are two problems with <u>hero</u> worship.
    - It can feed the <u>flesh</u> of leaders.
    - People with favorites forget this is all about <u>Jesus</u>!
  - C. We will either see the power of God revealed or the cross emptied of its power.
  - D. Christian cannibalism is a thing.

- III. I Corinthians 1:18-31 Competing wisdoms
  - A. The cross is <u>foolish</u> or the <u>power</u> of God.
    - The Jews demanded <u>signs</u>.
    - The Greeks seek <u>universal</u> spirituality.
    - Godly Wisdom seeks after God.
  - B. Paul says consider <u>yourself</u> as a case-study.
