# THE GOAL IS Restoration

I Corinthians 5-7 deals with <u>morality</u> and <u>ethics</u> of believers.

- I Corinthians 5:1-2 sums up what is at the root.
  - A. Immorality of the individual
  - B. Arrogance of the church body

- II. I Corinthians 5:3-5 gives them Holy Spirit instruction to <u>confront</u> this sin.
  - A. Paul takes <u>spiritual</u> authority to pass judgment on this man's sin.
  - B. This sinful behavior is <u>never</u> ok with God.

- III. I Corinthians 5:6-13 speaks to the church and church leadership about their responsibility.
  - A. 5:6-8 Paul says they need to understand the <u>consequence</u> of their arrogance.
  - B. 5:9-13 Hold people accountable who are <u>in</u> the church community, not judging those who are <u>outside</u> the church community.

- III. I Corinthians 5:6-13 speaks to the church and church leadership about their responsibility.
  - C. CHURCH, we need to get this straight.
    - God <u>loves</u> sinners.
    - When the Spirit of God moves <u>IN</u>, evil has to move <u>OUT</u>.
    - The more <u>dead</u> I am to myself, the more <u>alive</u> I am in Christ.
    - The more we come alive in Christ, the more the grip of sin in us <u>dies</u>.

#### To be like Jesus we need to:

- 1. Show people enough <u>grace</u> that they can hear the <u>truth</u>.
- 2. Know if the person <u>claims</u> Christ.
- 3. Approach them from a place of <u>love</u>, not arrogance.
- 4. Approach them after a time of <u>prayer</u> and <u>discernment</u>.

The goal is restoration.
