


- A. Who celebrated Jesus?
 - 1. A "great crowd" came up V. 12
 - 2. Christ was honored more by these simple people, rather than the pharisees

- B. When did they celebrate him? V.12
 - 1. When they <u>heard</u> he was coming to Jerusalem for the Passover feast.
 - They heard because people were <u>talking</u> about the <u>miracle</u> at Bethany.

- C. How did they celebrate him? V.13
 - 1. Palm branches, singing, shouting and cheering
 - 2. Shouting "Hosanna" which means "please save us"
 - 3. They welcomed him into <u>Jerusalem</u>, and affirmed him as their <u>King</u>, the promised <u>Messiah</u>.

- D. How did Jesus respond? V.14-15
 - 1. He fulfilled <u>prophecy</u> and rode on a young donkey, polarizing the people!
 - Psalm 118:26: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord! We bless you from the house of the Lord."
 - He is a mild and approachable king.





- E. How did the <u>disciples</u> respond? V.16
 - 1. They <u>participated</u>, but did not understand.
- F. How did the Pharisees respond? V.19
 - 1. They were learning some vital <u>truth</u>:
 - 1. Resistance to King Jesus is absolutely futile.
 - 2.The "whole world" will indeed <u>bow</u> and <u>worship</u> him, one way or another!

- G. This wonderful story mirror's how we worship today:
- H. This wonderful story mirror's <u>future</u> <u>worship</u> as well:

- I. "He is Lord, He is Lord..."
 - A. All <u>past</u>, <u>present</u>, and <u>future</u> worship belongs to Jesus.
 - B. No one, no matter how hard they try, will <u>escape</u> this <u>truth</u>.
