

II. **Author** of the gifts

A. The author is **Holy Spirit**.

- God **empowers** each gift.
- God **appoints** each gift.
- God **composes** the gifts.
- God **apportions** each gift.

III. Variety of the gifts

A. An infinite variety of good gifts

B. Three different groups of spiritual gifts

- Different spiritual gifts proper:

charismata

- Different services (ministries)

- Different activities

C. Each are given different

manifestations of the Spirit (the invisible being made visible)
