Mistakes of the gifts
 A. Don't be <u>led</u> astray.
 B. Don't be <u>uninformed</u>.

II. <u>Author</u> of the gifts A. The author is <u>Holy Spirit</u>. God <u>empowers</u> each gift. God <u>appoints</u> each gift. God <u>composes</u> the gifts. God <u>apportions</u> each gift.

III. Variety of the gifts A. An *infinite* variety of good gifts B. Three different groups of spiritual gifts Different spiritual gifts proper: charismata • Different <u>services</u> (ministries) • Different activities C. Each are given different manifestations of the Spirit (the invisible being made visible)

IV. <u>Purpose</u> of the gifts – a memorable analogy (the church is a body) A. So that His church can **function** properly B. So that His church better represents Christ C. So that His church lives in **unity**
