

We need to see <u>Jesus</u> as God's standard revealed in Scripture.

- 1. 15:35-41... Consider a **kernel** of grain.
  - A. It is not until it is <u>planted</u> that it can release the potential of what it carries; then it multiplies.
  - B. Within each kernel **DNA** is already present to determine what that kernel will produce.
  - C. When we go to our grave as believers in Jesus, what is raised up is <u>totally</u> transformed.

- II. 15:42-44 Where there is a natural body, there is a **spiritual** body.
  - A. A myth that ought to be laid to rest by now is if you can't <u>see</u> it, it doesn't <u>exist</u>.
  - B. Others let their **imaginations** run wild.

- III. 15:45-49 Our <u>connection</u> with Adam and Jesus.
  - A. We get our <u>earthly</u> traits from Adam.

    We receive our <u>heavenly</u> traits from Jesus.
  - B. Just as we have borne the image of <a href="Mailto:Adam">Adam</a>...

So we will bear the image of <u>Jesus</u>.

15:50 <u>Contaminated</u> flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, the perishable does not inherit the imperishable.

That is the seed that comes to life.
