I. Jesus tells us how to think, do and what to teach.

A. “Do not think I have come to abolish the Law or prophets...”

B. Act and teach the significance of the Law and Prophets.

C. Begin by saying, “God’s Word is True ...”

II. Your righteousness needs to exceed that of the scribes and Pharisees.

A. For the scribes and the Pharisees this was a problem.

B. They needed to Un-learn before they could Re-learn.



III. My hope is that this passage is an epiphany.

A. “You therefore must be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect.”

B. Most of the time this is a process, and I believe God shows grace in our process.

Is there anything going on today in your life where you know *in that place* you are trying to live outside of the mind and heart of God?

It is convenient to be legalistic. It is easier to know where “the line” is.
