

- I. Jesus tells us how to <u>think</u>, <u>do</u> and what to <u>teach</u>.
 - A. "Do not <u>think</u> I have come to abolish the Law or prophets..."
 - B. Act and teach the significance of the Law and Prophets.
 - C. Begin by saying, "God's Word is True ..."

- II. Your <u>righteousness</u> needs to exceed that of the scribes and Pharisees.
 - A. For the scribes and the Pharisees this was a <u>problem</u>.
 - B. They needed to \underline{Un} -learn before they could \underline{Re} -learn.
