It is impossible to <u>serve</u> two masters.

Jesus goes to war against a hypocrisy that produces <u>deception</u>.

I. The first deception: When we think we can be a follower of Jesus AND treasure what is <u>earthly</u>

A. An internal deception: we are <u>fooling</u> ourselves.

B. A healthy eye is a <u>trained</u> eye.

C. Treasures: the place where precious goods are <u>stored</u>

II. The second deception: I can serve <u>two</u> masters.

A. We are buying into the <u>lie</u> that we can do both.

B. You <u>cannot</u> serve God and money/mammon.

III. The third deception: My anxiety is because I have to depend on <u>ME</u> for whatever <u>I</u> need to live.

A. We are back to believing we can serve two masters; only this time it is God and **ourselves**.
