



I. When we read the title  
“Jesus Christ,” we can think  
of it as “Jesus the Christ.”

“Christ” means anointed one.



II. Betrothal is not the same as engagement.

A. During betrothal, the groom prepared a place for his bride.

B. Jesus is preparing a place for His bride, the Church.

C. Joseph honored Mary, even when it seemed that she had dishonored him.



III. The angel calls Joseph a son of David to remind him of his identity.

A. The name Jesus, or in Hebrew, Joshua, means “Yahweh saves.”

B. “Emmanuel” (God with us) is a title.

C. Joseph responds with quick obedience.



IV. Prophecies in Scripture are really God's promises.
