I. When we read the title "Jesus Christ," we can think of it as "Jesus **the** Christ."

"Christ" means anointed one.

- II. Betrothal is not the same as engagement.
  - A. During betrothal, the groom prepared a <u>place</u> for his bride.
  - B. Jesus is preparing a place for His bride, the **Church**.
  - C. Joseph <u>honored</u> Mary, even when it seemed that she had dishonored him.

- III. The angel calls Joseph a son of David to remind him of his <a href="identity">identity</a>.
  - A. The name Jesus, or in Hebrew, Joshua, means "Yahweh saves."
  - B. "Emmanuel" (God with us) is a <u>title</u>.
  - C. Joseph responds with **quick obedience**.
