Three stories packed into 4 verses

- I. The story with <u>real</u> characters discussing fasting
 - A. Strange bedfellows standing together
 - Trying to <u>preserve</u> familiar traditions
 - Some are of God, some aren't.
 - It takes discernment.
 - They didn't <u>adjust</u> to the presence of Jesus.

- Three stories packed into 4 verses
- II. The story of an <u>old</u> garment
 - A. It may be inferred the garment isn't worth <u>preserving</u>.
 - Sometimes it's wise to let some things die.
 - B. It's a <u>mistake</u> to patch an old worn out tradition with a little bit of new.

Three <u>stories</u> packed into 4 verses III. The story of wine and <u>wineskins</u>

- A. New Wine represents the <u>Good News</u> of Jesus Christ.
 - It can be <u>lost</u> if we don't preserve it properly.

Three <u>stories</u> packed into 4 verses III. The story of wine and <u>wineskins</u>

- B. Wineskins represent <u>people</u>.
 - Which type of wineskin are you?
 - "New" wineskin refers to <u>freshness</u> for the job.
 - It needs to be supple.
 - Because New Wine <u>percolates</u>
