To see Jesus is to see:

- I. That God rewards those who follow/labor for Jesus.
 - A. They will receive because they walked away from what they had and followed Him.
 - B. All followers walk away from something.
 - C. Problem: Seeing rewards as earnings instead of unmerited favor from a generous God.

To see Jesus is to see:

II. The truth that God is not indebted to anyone.

A. God does not have the capacity to cheat anyone.

B. The gift of eternity alone is gift enough.

C. Yet because we look over our shoulders we begin to compare (like Peter did with John).

To see Jesus is to see:

III. The generosity of our Father God

A. John 3:16-17 tells us of the generosity of God.

B. Romans 3:23-24 tells us of the generosity of God.

C. God is generous with what belongs to HIM!

“Many who are first will be last,

How we receive the generosity of God
matters to our Father.
