What began with a question
turned into an education.

- I. Lesson 1: Ask Jesus what you want but He will answer what you need.
 - A. They asked Jesus a question but that did not give them control of His answer.
 - B. Instead of accepting their premise Jesus told them what they needed to hear.

- II. Lesson 2: Jesus wants to reframe your mind to receive His answer.
 - A. Greatness is about responsibility.
 - B. To be great, reverse course, allow God to reframe how you think, and humble yourself.
 - C. Do welcome, protect, and lead.
 - D. Do not despise, do not look down, do not think "less than" when you look at a child.

III. Lesson 3: Jesus says there are serious consequences in His definition of greatness.

A. Jesus had foresight and an agenda.

B. Their angels see the face of My Father.

C. There is a plan for those children who wander.
