- I. As Jesus' followers waited in the upper room, they <u>devoted</u> themselves to prayer.
 - A.This means they "persisted," or "steadfastly continued" in prayer.

 B.They expected God to keep His word.

- II. As Peter is praying, he has <u>scripture</u> brought to mind.
 - A.These passages lead him to believe that they are to fill Judas' vacated office of apostle.
 - B.Apostle refers to someone who is "sent out."

III. Peter <u>tests</u> what he's hearing with the rest of the group.

IV. They start with prayer, and they end with <u>prayer</u>.

Do you start with prayer? Do you turn to Scripture? Do you **test** it with other believers? Do you trust God's will?
