Are we empowering those <u>gifted</u> by Christ to <u>equip</u> the saints for the work of ministry for building up the body of Christ?

- I. Are we equipping you saints well?
 - A. Equip for 2 purposes:
 - For the work of ministry
 - For <u>building up</u> the body of Christ
 - B. To be adequately equipped/resourced to do the work of ministry in <u>specific</u> and <u>peculiar</u> ways.

- II. Have we <u>blurred</u> the lines of those gifted by Christ?
 - A. Teacher Their mission: <u>Discover</u> knowledge
 - Their service: Educate the body of Christ
 - B. Pastor/Shepherd Show the <u>Father's</u> mercy, liberate from guilt, loose what is bound

- II. Have we <u>blurred</u> the lines of those gifted by Christ?
 - C. Evangelist A messenger of GOOD

 News
 - D. Prophet In tune with the <u>counsel</u> of God
 - E. Apostle They don't just go; they are <u>sent</u>. The focus of these 5 assignments is on the <u>work</u>.

- III. Have we <u>hesitated</u> to go all in?
 Too many of us have been taught:
 - A. We can do <u>anything</u> if we put our minds to it.
 - B. We can do whatever it is by ourselves.
 - C. We can't <u>trust</u> passages like Ephesians 4:11-12.

To turn the Holy Spirit loose is to turn those <u>gifted</u> by God loose to do what God has uniquely gifted each one to do.

Walk <u>beside</u> each other even when mistakes are made.

As we do, each can <u>mature</u> into adulthood, into the full measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.
