



- I. The invitation: "COME ... Come to Me."
 - A. The invitation is to <u>everyone</u> who thirsts.
 - B. Listen to ME says God says.
 - C. To tune into <u>God</u>, tune other voices <u>out</u>.

- II. The challenge: "Seek the Lord while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near."
 - A. Two competing thoughts:
 - Through Jesus Christ God is <u>always</u> near.
 - There are <u>seasons</u> when it seems God is more near.

- II. The challenge: "Seek the Lord while He may be found; call upon Him while He is near."
 - B. If you "forsake His way" at least know what you are walking <u>away</u> from.
 - C. "His ways are <u>not</u> our ways and His thoughts are <u>not</u> our thoughts..."

- III. The promise: the word of God that goes out from His mouth will <u>accomplish</u> what God said.
 - A. What God says is true, simple, and full of hope.
 - B. We live in a world that confuses <u>hype</u> as hope.
 - C. Do you want to go out in joy and be lead forth in peace?
