- I. Hezekiah believed the Lord and <u>cried</u> <u>out</u> to Him.
  - A. Hezekiah <u>heard</u>: knew it was the word of God.
  - B. Hezekiah turned his face to the wall.
  - C. Hezekiah <u>pled</u> his case.

- II. God heard his cry and gave him another word.
  - A. "Isaiah, <u>turn</u> <u>around</u> and go back to Hezekiah."
    - 1. I have <u>heard</u> you.
    - 2. I have <u>seen</u> your tears.
    - 3. I am <u>adding</u> 15 years to your life.
    - 4. I will <u>deliver</u> you and this city.
    - 5. I will defend this city.

- II. God heard his cry and gave him another word.
  - A. "Isaiah, <u>turn</u> <u>around</u> and go back to Hezekiah."
  - B. How can you be confident? Here is your <u>sign</u>.

- III. With blessings come new levels of Godly Adulting.
  - A. Guests show up and Hezekiah shows them <u>everything</u>.
  - B. Instead of stepping <u>up</u> he sat <u>down</u>.
  - C. Hezekiah is <u>content</u> to hear that there will be peace and security in His days.

I want another <u>season</u> of Ebenezer experiences.

If God grants me a new season I don't want to <u>waste</u> it.

New seasons <u>begin</u> with desperate cries.

New seasons <u>demand</u> that we confess/give witness to the powerful, miraculous shaking and shifting of God.
