Three key <u>obstacles</u> that can keep us from believing in or accepting God visits...

- I. Do you feel <u>unworthy</u> of a God visit?
  - A. Mary also felt insignificant.
  - B. But God has a history of choosing and using the <u>unlikely</u>.
  - C. God <u>reassures</u> of our identity in Him.

- II. Do you get so caught up in the <u>how</u> that you miss the <u>what</u> and the <u>why</u>?
  - A. When God reveals Truth to us, we don't have to <u>figure</u> <u>out</u> the how. That's God's job!

- III. Are you willing to let the power of the Most High <u>overshadow</u> you?
  - A. In our relationship with God, there is a <a href="hierarchy">hierarchy</a>.
  - B. One of us is the <u>Creator</u>, and one of us is the <u>created</u>.
  - C. When God tells us His plans for us, it's because He wants us to choose to <a href="mailto:partner">partner</a> with Him.

- III. Are you willing to let the power of the Most High <u>overshadow</u> you?
  - D. He doesn't overshadow us with the Holy Spirit to put us down; He does it to <a href="strengthen">strengthen</a> us.
