I. As a Gentile :

A. Glad Holy Spirit was clear in the message.

B. Glad Paul stood his ground while under attack.

C. Glad that Titus was not forced to follow ritualistic legalism.



II. As a Believer :

A. Glad false brothers and sisters are exposed .

B. Glad for the courage of those who stood their ground against the attempts of spiritual slavery .



### III. As a Leader:

- A. Glad for Holy Spirit revelation that stays true to Scripture.
- B. Glad that those with influence saw God's grace in Paul and Barnabas.
- C. Glad for the right hand of fellowship:  
Not because of position but credibility.




III. As a Leader:
