

I. Preaching JESUS.

A. They preached Jesus to pagans that were not on the rest of the church's radar.

B. When the report reached Jerusalem, Jerusalem sent Barnabas to investigate.

C. To preach means to bring GOOD NEWS!



II. Remaining faithful with Steadfast
PUPRPOSE

A. Barnabas exhorted them.

B. Lay the purpose of your heart before the Lord.
