

- I. Preaching <u>JESUS</u>.
 - A. They preached Jesus to <u>pagans</u> that were not on the rest of the church's radar.
 - B. When the report reached Jerusalem, Jerusalem sent Barnabas to <u>investigate</u>.
 - C. To preach means to bring **GOOD NEWS**

II. Remaining faithful with Steadfast PUPRPOSE

- A. Barnabas <u>exhorted</u> them.
- B. Lay the <u>purpose</u> of your heart before the Lord.
- C. A "God Wink..." The disciples were first called <u>Christians</u> in Antioch.

III. Trusting God's Word and God's Spirit

- A. They cast hope when <u>teaching</u> God's Word.
- B. They cast hope by trusting Holy Spirit.
- C. Inside information is a personal <u>invitation</u> to join God in His work

- IV. Participating in Transformational WORSHIP.
 - A. They worshipped, prayed, fasted and <u>listened</u>.
 - B. Becoming the epicenter of the <u>sending</u> church.
 - C. Barnabas and Paul were <u>released</u> by the church and <u>sent</u> by the Holy Spirit.
