Revelation

- Salvation: a <u>free</u> gift of life.
- Justification: the <u>legal</u> action recognized by God where we are acquitted of our sin.
- Sanctification: the process of being set <u>apart</u>.

- I. Paul asks a <u>loaded</u> question.
  - A. O <u>foolish</u> Galatians!
  - B. Who has bewitched you?

- II. Paul <u>interrogates</u> their faith by asking questions.
  - A. Did you receive The Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?
  - B. Are you so foolish that you are now trusting your <u>becoming</u> based on what YOU can do?
  - C. Did you <u>suffer</u> so many things in vain?

- II. Paul <u>interrogates</u> their faith by asking questions.
  - D. Does He who supplies the Spirit and works miracles do so because of the way you satisfy or accomplish the <a href="law">1aw</a> or by hearing with <a href="faith">faith</a>?

- III. Paul instructs them to KNOW THEN.
  - A. Paul says to get this <u>settled</u> in your mind.
  - B. Gentile <u>justification</u> before God was prophesied.
  - C. Just like <u>Abraham</u>: He did not have the Law.
