- Salvation: a free gift of life.
- Justification: the legal action recognized by God where we are acquitted of our sin.
- Sanctification: the process of being set apart.

- I. Paul asks a loaded question.
  - A. O foolish Galatians!
  - B. Who has bewitched you?

II. Paul interrogates their faith by asking questions.

A. Did you receive The Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith?

B. Are you so foolish that you are now trusting your becoming based on what YOU can do?

C. Did you suffer so many things in vain?

II. Paul interrogates their faith by asking questions.

D. Does He who supplies the Spirit and works miracles do so because of the way you satisfy or accomplish the law or by hearing with faith ?

- III. Paul instructs them to KNOW THEN.
  - A. Paul says to get this settled in your mind.
  - B. Gentile justification before God was prophesied.
  - C. Just like Abraham : He did not have the Law.
