B. But the law was a temporary guardian.

III. The law helped to reveal and to train our hearts.

A. The thing that matters is not just keeping the law. It's not about technicalities; it's about your intentions.

B. It's also not about obeying the laws for your own glory.

“Now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian.”
