 The thesis: You cannot gain justification by <u>obeying rules</u>. You can only be justified through <u>faith</u> in Jesus.

- JUSTIFICATION: the <u>legal</u> action where God declared unrighteous people to be righteous; <u>acquitting</u> us from sin's penalty because of Christ's death on the cross
- SANCTIFICATION: the <u>process</u> of being set apart to become holy; more and more like Jesus and guided by the Holy Spirit

Justification

- Legal standing with God
- Once for all time
- Entirely God's work
- Perfect and complete in this life
- The same in all Christians
- Sin doesn't damage

Sanctification

- Becoming more like God
- Continuous throughout life
- We cooperate
- Not perfect or complete in this life
- Greater in some than in others
- Sin does damage

We acknowledge the Scripture as the authoritative source and standard for preaching and teaching about faith and life, for distinguishing truth from error, for discerning between good and evil, and for guiding prayer and worship.
