There are four key words Jesus uses to draw an <u>inseparable</u> line between Himself and God the Father.

- I. HONOR John 5:19-24
 - A. Jesus gives honor <u>TO</u> His Heavenly Father.
 - B. Jesus receives honor <u>FROM</u> God the Father. John 1:32-34, John 3:16
 - C. Whoever does not <u>honor</u> the Son does not <u>honor</u> the Father who sent Him.
 - D. It is <u>not possible</u> to honor God the Father if we do not honor God's Son.

II. AUTHORITY John 5:25-29

- A. Authority to raise the dead <u>physically</u>
- B. Authority to raise the dead spiritually
- C. This inseparable authority has <u>tripped</u> many people up.

III. WITNESS John 5:30-40

- A. The <u>legalistic</u> approach: build a fence.
- B. Jesus lined up His witnesses.

IV. <u>GLORY</u> John 5:41-46

- A. They used the wrong equation to calculate <u>glory</u>.
- B. Jesus was very <u>direct</u>.
- C. Moses would be come their primary accuser.
