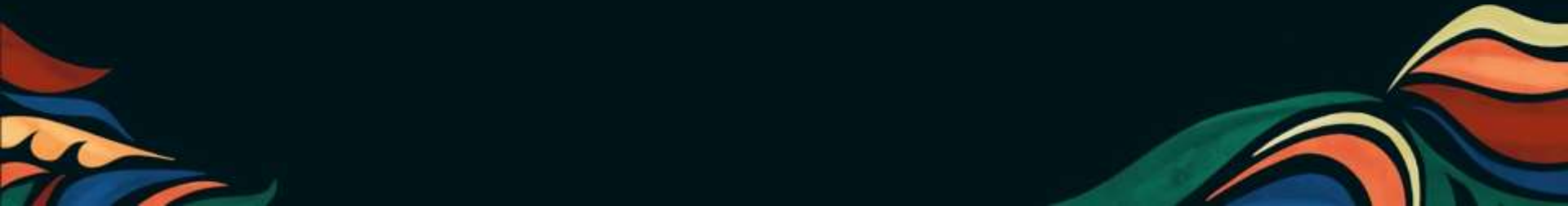

E. The crowd is about to take Jesus by force.

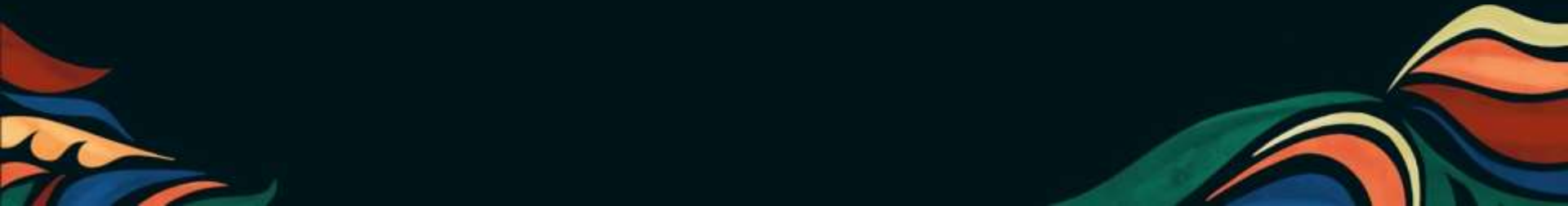


III. After the feeding

A. Of course, a storm kicks up

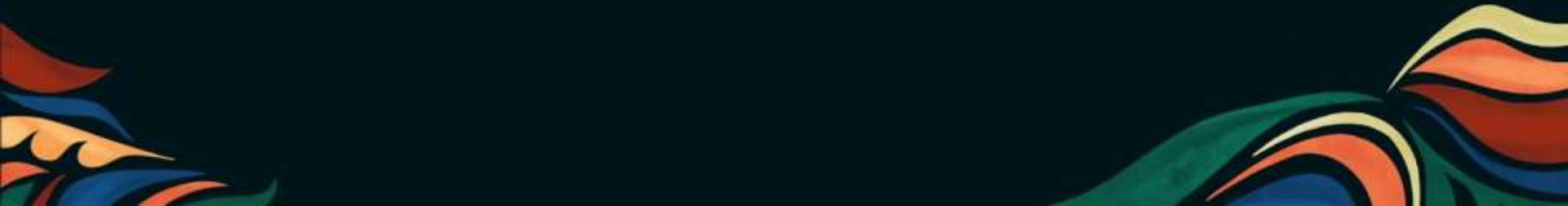
B. Jesus comes walking on the whitecaps
