Ask, seek and knock are <u>again</u> and <u>again</u> words. We like to <u>read</u> a good mystery, and <u>watch</u> a good mystery, but most of us don't want to <u>live</u> in the mystery.

- I. They were living into the "<u>loaves</u>" of Jesus.
 - A. They came looking for the Jesus they already $\underline{knew}.$ Feed me!
 - B. They saw the food but not the <u>sign</u>.
 - C. Jesus told them not to work for food that <u>spoils</u> but to work for food that <u>endures</u> to eternal life.

- II. They were blind and could not see the signs Jesus had <u>already</u> given.
 - A. What supernatural <u>token</u> can you give us?
 - B. Mindsets can become <u>strongholds</u>.

III. They were convinced there were no <u>mysteries</u> left.

A. "Sir (<u>continually</u>) give us this bread."
B. You do not <u>hunger</u> for God because you are <u>satisfied</u> with what you already have.

III. They were convinced there were no <u>mysteries</u> left.

C. Jesus was standing right in front of them and they could not see the "<u>I AM</u>."

D. This is the <u>will</u> of God (John 6:40).

"This is the work of God, that you believe in Him whom He has sent."
