



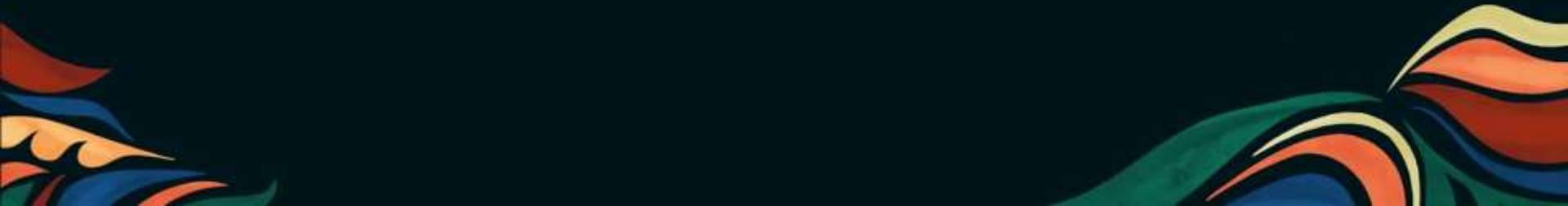

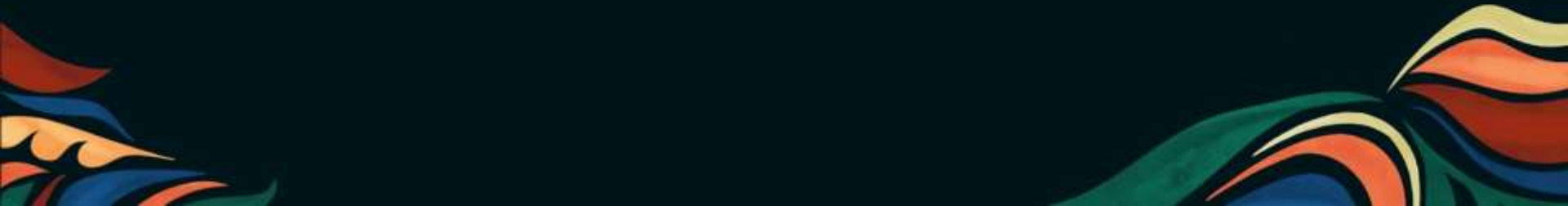

- B. But Jesus SEES him.



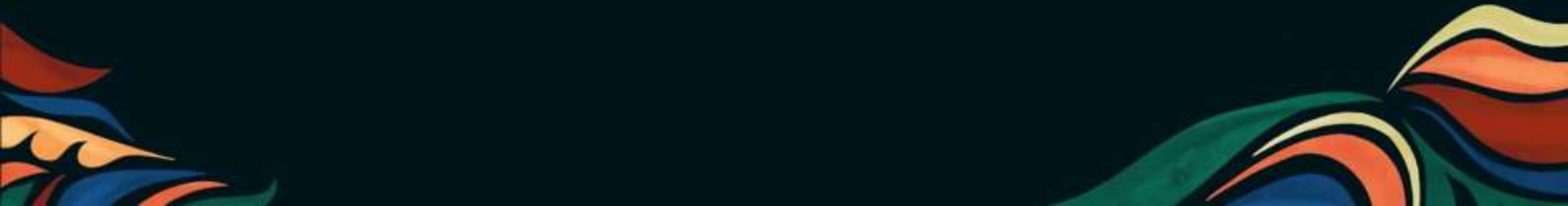
II. When the Jewish religious leaders see him, instead of focusing on his healing, all they can see is what he's doing wrong.
