


- I. "I AM the <u>Good</u> Shepherd. I <u>KNOW</u>

- II. "My Sheep <u>hear</u> My voice, and I <u>know</u> them, and they <u>follow</u> ME!"
 - A. When the Good Shepherd speaks, His sheep don't <u>ignore</u> what He says.
 - B. When the Good Shepherd speaks,His sheep pay attention and <u>follow</u> Him.

Because this is still true today, what does this mean for us?

- That Jesus is the <u>Good</u> Shepherd.
- That His sheep <u>can</u> hear and recognize His voice.
- That Jesus occupies the gate <u>protecting</u> His sheep.
- That He knows His sheep <u>fully</u> and His sheep are <u>growing</u> in understanding and knowing Him.
- That His sheep <u>trust</u> Him so much that we follow Him even through dark, intimidating valleys.
