

His Name Shall Be Called Everlasting Father

Isaiah 9:6

- I. God created us to be His children, and He delights in being our Everlasting Father.
 - A. As our Creator, God made us to have relationship with Him.
 - B. Sin ruined the relationship.
 - C. When we reject God's Fatherdom, we are like children in rebellion.

- II. But God is our Father of Eternity.
 - A. He pursues His children, desiring an eternal relationship with us.
 - B. One way God pursues us is through covenants.
 - C. The covenant cycle looks like:
 - Step One: Covenant
 - Step Two: Rebellion
 - Step Three: Pursuit
 - Step Four: Reconciliation

- III. God sent a final covenant sign: Jesus.
 - A. Like the previous covenants, this one is also a promise.
 - B. It is also eternal.
 - C. The promise of Jesus is a permanent, right relationship with God the Father.
 - D. We will have a full restoration of what was always meant to be!
