

# ***GIVE ME THE HILL COUNTRY***

Joshua 14:1-15

CALEB: an all-time favorite and Bible hero

- I. Lived with God-given CONVICTION
  - A. Caleb watched his family become a NATION.
  - B. After 40 days, 10 spies came back with reports that caused FEAR, fed by encounters with the enemy.
  - C. Caleb's conviction was fed by BELIEF in God.
  - D. Caleb lived with the conviction that this land ALREADY belonged to him/them.
  
- II. Stood on God's PROMISES
  - A. Caleb walked the hills RECEIVING this land as having been promised by God.
  - B. Caleb believed that the promise of God was TRUE.
  - C. The land of promise was becoming REALITY.
  - D. Caleb never forgot where his FEET had been.
  
- III. Pressed into his God-given DESTINY

FATE: implies an inevitable and usually adverse outcome  
DESTINY: implies foreordained with a great or noble end

  - A. Destiny requires PARTICIPATION.
  - B. *Destiny is what GOD declares and WE live into.***
  - C. Pressing into destiny requires FAITH: belief merged with my inability to comprehend.
