Romans 4 RIGHT THINKING UNDERSTANDS

- I. Justification: a court room term
 - A. Grudem: "an instantaneous legal act of <u>God</u>"
 God <u>thinks</u> of our sins as forgiven.
 God <u>declares</u> us to be righteous.
 - B. Vines: "the legal, formal acquittal from guilt"
 - C. To admit we are a sinner is true but it is not enough; that means we know we are <u>guilty</u>.
 - D. Romans 4:25 connects Jesus' death and <u>resurrection</u> with God's declaration.
- II. <u>Righteousness</u>: defined by character and loyalty
 - A. Character: qualities that consistently define us.
 - B. Loyalty: speaks to a person's <u>allegiance</u>.
 - C. Credited: God took inventory of Abraham.
- III. <u>Faith:</u> arguably is an action word.
 - A. Hebrews 11:1 "Faith <u>IS</u> the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen."
 - B. Faith looks a lot like <u>Abraham</u>.
 - C. Faith means <u>acting in</u> obedience, not putting faith in our obedience.
- I pray we <u>rest</u> in the grace of Jesus Christ.
- I pray we live with <u>Godly</u> hope against all earthly hope.
- I pray the promise of God would not <u>stagger</u> us but our faith in times of uncertainty would give God glory.
- I pray we will be fully <u>convinced</u> that God is able.
