HEAR THE WARNING SIRENS

Romans 2

Hear the alarms Paul was sounding to the **Church** in Rome.

- I. Stop the <u>excuses</u>. Romans 2:1-3
 - A. Stop sitting in judgment of others.
 - B. As if we are better than someone else
 - C. Paul is not saying we have no capacity to speak <u>truth</u>, but check your attitude.
- II. Stop presuming upon God. Romans 2:4-13.
 - A. Romans 3:23: "<u>ALL</u> have sinned and fall short of the glory of God."
 - B. Paul says regardless of a person's heritage, <u>God</u> will render to each one according to his works.
 - C. We end up in a bad place when we <u>misinterpret</u> God's kindness, forbearance, and patience.
 - D. The purpose is to lead us to repentance.
- III. <u>Don't</u> be that guy. Romans 2:17-24.
 - A. How we carry ourselves is a <u>direct</u> reflection on God.
 - B. Paul is speaking to this <u>blend</u> of attitudes, behaviors, and leverage.
